Concessions & Merchandise sold during baseball this Saturday




The Edsel Athletic Boosters will be selling concessions and merchandise at the Double Header baseball game this Saturday, May 13. The first game starts at 11am.






Students who have dual enrollment must exit the building. There is no hanging out or roaming the halls. All students have signed a contract that they will find their own transportation.






On **Tues**, **May 16**, Seniors will wear School Spirit attire from the college they've chosen to attend!

Late Arrivals/Early Dismissals Due to the high call volume, we would like to remind parents for faster service please enter your child's absence through parent connect. State whether it is a full day, early dismissal, or late arrival and time. All students must sign in and out, so please have your child stop by the attendance office when they arrive at school to pick up their pass for late arrival/early dismissal to avoid delays.
