Parking Passes

•Parking is not permitted without a parking permit and parking in handicap spots is not allowed. Vehicles may be ticketed. Students wishing to park in the student parking lot must have a parking pass. Parking passes are \$20 and can be purchased from the main office starting on August 21st.

Students who have dual enrollment must exit the building. There is no hanging out or roaming the halls. All students have signed a contract that they will find their own transportation.

Student Tardy Policy

Audit reduces a student's credit for a class from 0.5 credits to 0.25 credits for having 10 or more absences in a class. Tardies impact your attendance as well. Every four tardies is an absence If a student does not recover the credit by passing the class, including receiving a 78% or better on the cumulative final exam, the student must take the class in **night school or summer school** to regain their full credit. Summer school costs \$350 a class and night school costs \$175 a class.

Late Arrivals/Early Dismissals Due to the high call volume, we would like to remind parents for faster service please enter your child's absence through parent connect. State whether it is a full day, early dismissal, or late arrival and time. All students must sign in and out, so please have your child stop by the attendance office when they arrive at school to pick up their

pass for late arrival/early dismissal to avoid delays. Thank you for your patience.



Yellow Late Pass from Attendance Office: Students who arrive late to school after 8:05 are receiving a yellow late pass.
