

Out of School Program Positions

1. Tutor

- \$16.00 per hour, 12 hours per week
- High school students at least 17 years of age
- At least 6 college credits from an accredited college/university/or 6 courses through Master Teacher as assigned by ACCESS
- GPA of at least 2.75 GPA (can be overall or in English and Math classes)
- Primary Responsibilities: Support activity facilitators with sessions, serving supper, homework help and tutoring

2. <u>Instructor I</u>

- \$19.00 per hour, 13 hours per week
- GPA of at least 2.75 (can be overall or in ELA and Math classes)
- 60 college credits or an Associate Degree in Education or a youth-related field
- 2 years of classroom teaching experience or equivalent combination of experience, education, and/or training approved by Human Resources
- Primary Responsibilities: Activity facilitator responsible for all components of facilitating a program session

3. Instructor II

- \$21.00 per hour, 13 hours per week
- Bachelor's Degree or 120 credit hours from an accredited university/college in Elementary or Secondary Education, or a youth-related field
- At least 2 years of experience in an educational setting and/or any equivalent combination of experience, education, and/or training approved by Human Resources
- Primary Responsibilities: Activity facilitator responsible for all components of facilitating a program session.

4. Certified Teacher

- \$30.00 per hour, 13 hours per week
- Bachelor's Degree in Elementary or Secondary Education
- Valid Teaching Certificate
- At least 2 years of experience in an educational setting and/or any equivalent combination of experience, education, and/or training approved by Human Resources
- Primary Responsibilities: Activity facilitator responsible for all components of facilitating a program session.

5. Educational Site Leader*

- Part Time: \$24.35 per hour, hours vary based on availability but will not exceed 28 hours per week.
- Full Time: \$24.35 per hour + benefits, 35 hours per week
- Bachelor's Degree or 120 credit hours from an accredited university/college in Elementary or Secondary Education, or a youth-related field
- At least 2 years of experience in an educational setting and/or any equivalent combination of experience, education, and/or training approved by Human Resources
- Primary Responsibilities: Day-to-day management of the site, School Day collaboration and alignment, supervision of site staff, review, edit, and advise site's lesson plans.
- * There is one Educational Site Leader per site; either a full time or part time Educational Site Leader will be hired for the program
