Please be reassured that we take the safety of our students as high priority at Edsel Ford. We made sure students assembled in a safe manner, had the Dearborn Police present, and several staff to support student safety.

As a reminder to all students and families, we have our counselors and social workers at hand and accessible to all students if they need social/emotional support in processing the events occurring in the Middle East.

In addition, we have a comprehensive plan in place and are currently reviewing all safety measures.
