We will continue to work with Dearborn Police to identify those involved and determine the facts surrounding this isolated incident.

This type of behavior is not part of the culture and climate at our school and is never acceptable. There is a great deal of pride at Edsel Ford and we will not let this type of inappropriate behavior exist at our school.
