


# Pick Up and Drop Off



# District's Operating Millage-Vote on Feb 27th

The next election in Michigan will be held on Feb. 27, 2024. In addition to being a presidential primary, the ballot will also contain a question asking voters about the District's Operating Millage. It is NOT a new tax, and it is NOT a bond for building renovations or infrastructure. If it is not renewed, the district would fall to one of the lowest per pupil funding revenues in the state and be forced to make cuts across most schools and programs. ## **Student Tardy Policy and Student Attendance Policy**



Please review the Student Tardy Policy and Student High School Attendance Policy

Audit reduces a student's credit for a class from 0.5 credits to 0.25 credits for having 10 or more absences in a class. Absences include BOTH excused and unexcused absences. Tardies impact your attendance as well. Every four tardies is an absence If a student does not recover the credit by passing the class, including receiving a 78% or better on the cumulative final exam, the student must attend the class in night school or summer school to regain their full credit. Summer school costs \$350 a class and night school costs \$175 a class.

Late Arrivals/Early Dismissals Due to the high call volume, we would like to remind parents for faster service please enter your child's absence through parent connect. State whether it is a full day, early dismissal, or late arrival and time.
