

Join Congresswoman Rashida Tlaib for an Art Competition

Students, grades 9th -12th, are invited to join a nationwide high school arts competition sponsored by the Members of the U.S. House of Representatives. The winning artwork from our district will be displayed for one year in the U.S. Capitol. The winning artwork will also be featured on the U.S. House of Representatives' <u>Congressional Art Competition</u> page and the student will be flown to D.C. for a recognition ceremony on Thursday, June 27th.

The following is a summary of the Congressional Art Competition rules: Artwork entered in the contest may be up to 26" x 26" x 4", and not weigh more than 15 pounds. If your artwork is selected as the winning piece, it must arrive framed and must still measure no larger than the above maximum dimensions.

- Paintings including oil, acrylics, and watercolor.
- Drawings including pastels, colored pencils, pencil, charcoal, ink, and markers (It is recommended that charcoal and pastel drawings be fixed.)
- Collages must be two dimensional.
- Prints including lithographs, silkscreen, and block prints.
- Mixed Media use of more than two mediums such as pencil, ink, watercolor, etc.
- **Computer-generated art**
- Photography

The deadline for submission is Friday, May 3rd by 5 pm. Submissions should be dropped off at 7800 W. Outer Dr., Suite 203, Detroit, MI 48235. 
Student Cell Phone Policy

- **NO Cell Phones**: During the school day, students should have their personal electronic devices (smart phones) off; this includes earbuds. Students may use them during lunchtime.

Student Tardy Policy and Student Attendance Policy

Please review the <u>Student Tardy Policy</u> and <u>Student High School Attendance Policy</u> Audit reduces a student's credit for a class from 0.5 credits to 0.25 credits for having 10 or more absences in a class. Absences include BOTH excused and unexcused absences. Tardies impact your attendance as well. Every four tardies is an absence If a student does not recover the credit by passing the class, including receiving a 78% or better on the cumulative final exam, the student must attend the class in night school or summer school to regain their full credit. Summer school costs \$350 a class and night school costs \$175 a class.
