

students from the Pelham side of the building. This is a safety risk to not only students but also our staff. Dearborn Police will be issuing tickets.


Parents dropping off or picking up their student should enter the main entrance off of Rotunda or drop off their student at the gymnasium entrance.

## ALL Dual Enrollment Students


Students who have dual enrollment must exit the building. There is no hanging out or roaming the halls. All students have signed a contract that they will find their own transportation.
