Congratulations to the boys track and field team for beating Wyandotte, Trenton, Lincoln Park, and Taylor at the first Downriver League Quint-Meet. Leading the way, was Ubaid Abdul-Rahim who placed first in the 100, 200, and long jump. Abdu Eljahmi finished first in the 1600 and second in the 800 and Henry Vena won the 3200. Also finishing in first place for the boys team was the 4x800 relay team of Caleb Willson, Zin Salam, Chiso Willson, and Henry Vena. Other good performances included Gabe Beauchamp placing second in the 3200, Rylie Vance placing second in the 10 hurdles, Junaid Abdul-Rahim placing third in the 400, Zin Salam placing third in the 300 hurdles, and Jaxon Macey finishing third in the 3200.

The girls' track and field team beat both Taylor and Lincoln Park. Leading the way on the girl's side was Fiona Kane who won the long jump by tying her own school record for the second time this year and finishing second in the 200.

Fiona also ran on the winning 4x100 relay team, which included Maisy Gerlach, Sarah Mackie, and Ayva Mathis. Also finishing in first was Bella Marcoux in the high jump. Other good performances included Ayva Mathis finishing second in the 100 and third in the 200, Bella Marcoux and Margaret Malone tying for third in the pole vault, Margaret Malone tying for third in the high jump, and Kenzie Grizzell finishing in third in the 300 hurdles.

Parents dropping off or picking up their student should enter the main entrance off of Rotunda or drop off their student at the gymnasium entrance.



Parking Passes



- Parking is not permitted without a parking permit and parking in handicap spots is not allowed. Vehicles will be ticketed. Please be sure to place your parking pass in the front window. Students wishing to park in the student parking lot must have a parking pass. Parking passes are \$20 and can be purchased from the main office.



Lunch



- Edsel High School is a closed campus. No students are to leave Edsel High School for lunch. Any students caught doing so will receive either an out of school suspension or other school consequences. Students are to remain within the school building until their school day is completed based on their schedule. In addition, students are not permitted to order from DoorDash, GrubHub, etc. Parents, we ask you to not order food for your child and have it delivered to the school. This is a safety concern. We do not know who the doordash drivers are and we will not allow them to come into our schools. We appreciate you all adhering and respecting the safety of all of our students and staff.



School IDs



Edsel Ford students must have their picture taken and will be given a School ID card. Students are required to carry their ID's at all times while on school grounds. If their card is lost, they will be responsible for purchasing a replacement. Replacement cards can be purchased in our Attendance Office for \$5.

• Please remember this year school ends on JUNE 6, 2024 There will be finals the last week of school. Finals are required in person. FINAL EXAMS WILL BE DONE JUNE 5-6 (TBD). EARLY FINAL EXAMS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE. ALL STUDENTS MUST BE PRESENT DURING FINAL EXAM WEEK. No student will be excused from taking finals especially if they are on audit per the Administrators. Students/families who choose to leave for an early vacation must know that comes at a risk for students to receive a lower overall grade as well as may go on audit or even possibly receive an E letter grade. Audit reduces a student's credit for a class from 0.5 credits to 0.25 credits for having 10 or more absences in a class. Absences include BOTH excused and unexcused absences. Tardies impact your attendance as well. Every four tardies is an absence If a student does not recover the credit by passing the class, including receiving a 78% or better on the cumulative final exam, the student must attend the class in **night school or summer school** to regain their full credit. Summer school costs \$350 a class and night school costs \$175 a class. 1
